The Tower of London, officially known as *Her Majesty's Royal Palace and Fortress of the Tower of London*, is a historic castle in the center of Britain's capital city – and is part of 1,000 years of British History.

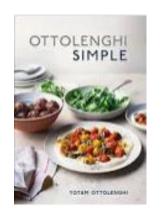


TASTE OF ENGLAND

KEEPING CURRENT WITH COVID-19



Maryland implemented a stricter face mask requirement and issued a travel advisory for states that are seeing surges in cases of the novel coronavirus.

Gov. Larry Hogan expanded mask-wearing restrictions mandating that everyone older than 5 must wear masks inside all public buildings, including restaurants, houses of worship, gyms, casinos, stores, office buildings and at outdoor events if it is not possible to maintain a safe physical distance of 6 feet between individuals.
